Infected Blood Inquiry (IBI) and Al-Sweady Public Inquiry

Kevin will share insights and learnings from two major inquiries, lasting 4.75 years and 4.25 years respectively. Hear the key challenges in dealing with multiple (400+) witnesses, physical searches of Government and paper repositories for evidence, and other key learnings for security and investigations professionals.

- Al-Sweady Public Inquiry started in 2010. The first-time retired police detectives had been used in
 a UK public inquiry; due the allegations of murder. In 2003 UK & USA and other nations use military
 force to overthrow Sadam Hussein. In 2004 (during the 're-building period') at Friday prayers, religious
 leaders used false information to incite a crowd to attack a British Army patrol. A 4-hour battle ensued
 in which a number of Iraqis were killed or arrested.
- Infected Blood Inquiry (IBI) started in 2018, and is due to publish its final report in October 2023. It was alleged that the UK Government between the late 1960's and 1993 had given people HIV and Hepatitis (B & C) via blood and blood products during treatment for haemophilia and operations.

Hacking from the Hotel and other Red Team War Stories – Lesson's learned for CSOs and CISOs

James has been (physical) red teaming for over a decade and has successfully infiltrated some of the world's largest organisations, including top-tier banks, Insurance, Legal, Healthcare, Critical National In-frastructure and other highly sensitive environments, all with a proud, never been caught record.
