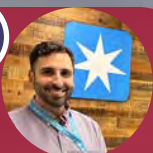

10:10 **Case Story: Billion-dollar decisions: applying intelligence tradecraft to corporate operations in the grey zone.**

Case material is drawn from geopolitically driven activism, conflict, and hybrid threats across the world of global logistics. The conversation is about how analytic rigor earns its place at the table when the stakes are, in fact, billion-dollar decisions, and the ground under our feet has never felt more unstable.

10:35 **Spotlight: Owning the AI Decision: A CSO's Operating Model for the Age of AI**

AI budgets are accelerating across the enterprise, yet much of that spend is being decided by the CIO and technology function, not by the people accountable for protecting the workforce. That leaves the Chief Security Officer with a defining choice: own the AI agenda for protecting people, assets and operations, or inherit tools chosen without security's duty of care in mind. This session gives CSOs a clear position to lead from: a practical three-part operating model - software for precision, AI for interpretation, humans for judgement - that keeps accountability and control firmly with the security leader while AI accelerates the response. Botan Osman explores how to make the investment case to the board, how to judge where your security operation genuinely sits on the path to AI-enabled operations, and how the model holds up against the threats a CSO actually manages - from regional crises and natural disasters to traveller safety incidents and major operational disruptions. Attendees leave with a working framework, and the language to defend it in the boardroom.
